Dear Parents/Carers,

The staff, pupils and governors are very appreciative of the support you have given in providing for learning at home for your child(ren.)

We realise that each family have their own routines and schedule for completing learning. Using ClassroomDojo as our main Remote Learning platform, allows you as a parent flexibility in supporting your child(ren) with learning set by the class teacher.

Following our recent Governors' Meeting, we feel it would be beneficial for pupils to interact with their classmates and teachers through MicroSoft Teams. There is an expectation that all pupils are to join a whole class activity session (30 mins) at least 3 times per week. These sessions would be built around an activity which focusses on pupils engaging with each other. During these sessions, a register will be taken for our records to show that your child has participated. Mr Johnson will also be holding a whole school Collective Worship on Fridays at 1pm which will be included in the 3 expected sessions.

The first Live Microsoft Teams session will be 1pm on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> February and will continue daily at 1pm until Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February. These sessions will restart following half-term on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February.

In addition to the above expected sessions, Class teachers will continue to provide Live Feedback sessions for Maths and English. Please check your child's ClassDojo story page for details.
