The position is to support a pupil with high needs

We are seeking to appoint an experienced, dedicated and enthusiastic 1:1 Teaching Assistant to support a wonderful child with special educational needs. The Teaching Assistant is crucial in ensuring that the curriculum is personalised for the individual pupil. The person appointed will be confident in adapting activities to allow the child in their care to make good or better progress and follow provisions as detailed in their Educational Health Care Plans. We require a Teaching Assistant that is confident with elements of personal care. The pupil enjoys being active but requires support to ensure their safety and inclusion in all school activities. The pupil will also require physical support and management of exercises which are set by a physiotherapist.

The post is linked to the child with the EHCP and is therefore temporary until the child leaves our school and/or upon successful completion of a six-month probationary period.

We need applicants who:

- Have knowledge and experience of supporting pupils with specific learning needs
- Have experience with personal care
- Are resilient, patient and able to cope with the physical demands that the posts will bring
- Can work in a calm, caring but firm and supportive manner
